I am in receipt of your letter of the 23rd ultimo. making report relative to the trip which you and the Hev. Pather Cadot and Chief Jones made to Walkerton to discuss with the Brune County Council the question of repairing roads adjacent to the Cape Croker Heserve; and in reply I beg to say that your fallure to set forth all the facts in the matter was the cause of misunderstanding Had you intimated that the proposed expenditure of \$500.00 was to be defrayed by the Bruce County Council upon the understanding that the Indians would do the work under the supervision of you and Mr. Whicher, the Department would have signified approval, and I may now state that if such work is undertaken it is hoped that you will see that it is done in a satisfactory manner.

You have the Department's authority to submit an account in detail covering the expenses of the trip taken to Walkerton as above referred to.
