1st Witness

Captain D. K. Black, R. C. E., (A.F.), who states:-  
"I am the Adjutant of No. 4 District Depot, (A.F.), and offer in evidence copy of extract from M. B. 68 of the 1st Battalion, Regiment de Maisonneuve, (A.F.), duly signed by the Custodian of the Regimental records, covering the absence of D-56404, Pte. A. Bouchard."

Gilbert, No. 14 Provost Coy., at Montreal, the 7th November, 1940, and was brought to me by the aforementioned Military Policeman. The soldier gave his name and number to me as recorded in the Certificate of Surrender. Private Gilbert, who brought the accused in, is no longer a member of No. 14 Provost Coy. and has been transferred to his Unit, the Fusiliers Mont-Royal, (A.F.), at C. I. (R) T. C., Valcartier, Que."
