the father or mother or guardian of the minor against the will of the head of such public or private charitable institution, or such private person without an order for such removal from a judge of the high court or from the judge of the county court of the county, or mayor or police magistrate of the city or town where the minor is, and the judge or other person hereby empowered to make an order for removal may refuse to grant an order for the removal of the minor unless he is satisfied that the removal will tend to the advantage and benefit of the minor.

By Order in Council the Children's Aid Societies of the Province have been given the powers conferred by this Act.
