ARTICLE IV.

Admission to the Society.

- Sec. 1. Every candidate for membership shall forward an application in writing to the Secretary, accompanied by an initiation fee of \$1.00. Such application shall state full name, address and place of nativity of the candidate; and shall be signed by two members of the Society in good standing as proposer and seconder of the same respectively.
- Sec. 2. All applications for membership shall be referred in the usual way to a committee of two members, who shall report in writing thereon at the next regular meeting of the Society.
- Sec. 3. Candidates duly recommended by the committee for membership shall be initiated as soon as convenient after their acceptance as such. The election shall be by ballot, and if three or more black balls be found the candidate shall be rejected.
- Sec. 4. Every candidate after initiation shall sign the Constitution and By-Laws of the Society.
