

ery, propelled by a twenty horse power engine, giving constant employment to eight hands, and turning out manufactured goods to the value of fifteen thousand dollars per annum. Adjoining the factory there is a steam saw mill employing a fifteen horse power engine, and sawing about half a million feet per annum. The factory and saw mill are owned by Winger & Weaver. There are three churches, two German Lutheran and one Wesleyan Methodist. The Lutheran church under the pastoral care of Rev. Mr. Koessman is built of log; the other was erected in 1862, of brick, Rev. Mr. Ernst, minister. The Wesleyan Methodist have a brick church erected in 1855, but no settled pastor. There is a superior common school with a large attendance, Geo. W. Woodward, principal; Miss Elizabeth Jamieson, assistant teacher. Mails daily. Population, 400.
