Perfons keeping a tavern without licence, or entertaining perfons, & felling ftrong liquoisin their houfes, liable to the fame penalty, to be recovered and applied in fame minner.

IV. And be it further enacted, That if any perfon or perfons shall keep a Tavern without having a licence given and granted as aforelaid, to him, her or them for that purpofe, and entering into recognizance as aforefaid, or without fuch licence to keep a tavern, and entering into recognizance as aforefaid, Thall entertain any perfon or perfons in his, her or their houfe, and shall fell to such perfon or perfons to entertained, any rum, brandy, wine, beer, ale, or any ftrong liquors, or mixed liquors, to be drank and confumed in his, her or their houfe, or any part of fuch house, such perfon or perfons to offending shall be fubject and liable to the fame penalty for each and every offence, as perfons felling by retail, without licence, and without entering into recognizance as aforefaid, are herein before made fubject and liable to be fued for, recovered, and applied in the fame manner, and to the fame ules and purpoles.

Persons licensed to keep tavern ;- to be licensed also to retail.

This aft to be read at the opening of the general feffions, and lifts of perfons licenced delivered to the grand jury.

And charge to be given to prefent offenders.

Juffices of general feffions to proceed on prefeniment, to recover pensities, in the manner herein before preferibed.

Penaluies and forfeitures to be paid into the county treasfury. Provided always, That any perfon or perfons to whom a licence shall be granted as aforefaid to keep a tavern, shall have included in such licence, a licence also to fell any strong liquors whatsoever by retail, without taking out a separate licence so to fell by retail.

V. And be it further enacted, That this act thall be publickly read by the Clerk at the opening of every Court of General Sellions of the Peace in the feveral counties in this province. and the Juffices of fuch courts shall at the fame time cause a lift of all the tavern-keepers and retailers respectively in their reforctive counties, to whom licence has been granted as aforefaid, to be delivered to the Grand Jurors at luch courts refrectively, and it shall be particularly given in charge to such Grand Jurors, to make diligent enquiry and prefentment of all and every fuch perfon and perfons as shall be guilty of any breach of, or offence against this act, contrary to the true intent and meaning thereof, and upon fuch prefentment, it shall and may be lawful for the Justices of fuch court to proceed against fuch offenders; in the manner herein before directed, to one Justice to proceed for the recovery of the penalties herein before inflicted, and upon conviction of fuch offender or offenders, before the Justices of fuch court, fuch penalty and penalties (hall upon the recovery thereof be paid into the hands of the respective county Treasurers for the fame uses and purposes, and subject to the fame orders and directions as the fums to be paid for licences, are herein before directed to be applied and fubject unto.
