H. PRESCOTT. By His Excellency HENRY PRESCOTT, Esquire, Companion of the Most Honorable Military Order of the Bath, Governor, and Commander-in-Chief, in and over the Island of Newfoundland, and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

Proclamation proroguing the General Assembly to the 7th Jan. 1836, then to meet for the dispatch of business

WHEREAS the General Assembly of this Island stands prorogued until Saturday the 31st day of October next: And whereas I think fit further to prorogue the said General Assembly until Thursday the Seventh day of January next, then to meet for the dispatch of business; of which all persons are required and commanded to take due notice and to govern themselves accordingly.

Given under my Hand and Seal at the Government House at St. John's, in the said Island, the 21st day of September, 1835, in the Sixth year of His Majesty's Reign.
