ONLY LET IT BE KNOWN THAT SUCH A SCHEME WAS A MOST WICKED ACT, THAT THE CRISIS OF THE NORTH IS A GOOD NIGHT'S SLEEP—LET IT BE RE-ADMITTED, PROMISE TO GET HIS LEADING MEN UP TO NORTHERN REVENUE AND PROMISE TO BEHAVE WELL FOR ALL TIME TO COME, AND THEN, IT MAY BE INSTATED, AFTER A LITTLE FURTHER SPLITTING AND CONFUSION. LINCOLN WILL HAVE AN ADMIRABLE PRETEXT FOR A FRESH DRAFT OF HALF A MILLION OF MEN! THIS PHASE OF THE AFFAIR HAS BEEN FORESHADOWED ALREADY THROUGH THE REPUBLICAN PRESS, FROM THE PULPIT OF H. W. BOECKER, THE ROSTRUM OF PARSON BROWNLOW AND THE BALCONY OF GEN. ## MINERAL LANDS IN UPPER CANADA.

The Globe's correspondent at Quebec sends the following:—The liberal policy adopted by Mr. McDougall in relation to the Lake Superior mineral lands, in the regulations of the 2d of March last, has had already its result. It is a complete vindication from the charges made by the Leader and other journals in the interest of old monopoly. It will be remembered that lands had been sold in 6,000 acre blocks, that the arrears were unpaid, and that the minerals were locked up. Mr. McDougall promptly promulgated the fully regulated, and ordered sales in 100 acre blocks at \$1 per acre, cash. The results are that about 20,000 acres of unsurveyed and otherwise unproductive Crown Lands have been sold, and \$30,000 cash received. The date at which the sales have been made are Thunder Bay, Duck Bay, St. Ignace and Pointe-au-Loup. Some fine specimens of iron ore are shown in the office of Mr. Davis, who has charge of Upper Canada mineral lands. These specimens are from the Lake Superior, and are of the iron ore of the Iron Mountains, at Goulais Bay, forty five miles from Saint-Sauveur. The ore is intersected with dark slate. Further developments may be expected, as active explorations are going on. The Government Surveyors who are running the Indian boundary, report finding boulders of iron ore on the surface. The American Company owning mineral lands in Goulais Bay propose constructing five miles of railway, to the shore, in the spring, and putting on a force of 150 men. It is proper to say that mineral lands are not on Indian territory, being the property of the Department of persons telegraphing applications for blocks in rear of certain bays. Of course, no notice could be taken of such applications.
