### SURGENTS WIN IN NICARAGUA

### BANK MOVEMENT PROVES SUCCESS

Generals Effect a Junction Will March on Managua Six Thousand Men Engaged in Battle

WASHINGTON, Feb. 5.—A telegram received at the navy department today from Capt. Shipleigh, commander of the gunboat Albatross, lying off Bluefields, Nicaragua, reports another engagement between the government and insurgent forces at Acopya in which the insurgents were reported to have been victorious. Capt. Shipleigh's advice were that the insurgents had a force of not less than 600 men engaged in the battle under Gen. Mena. The government forces are reported to have suffered heavy losses. Gen. Mena is reported to have forced the government to retire westward and they are placed between the insurgent forces under Gen. Mena and Gen. Chamorro.

### DRAWING THE LINE

Regulations Relative to Admission of Duty Free of Foreign Goods Will Be Strictly Enforced.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 4.—Revised regulations governing the admission free of duty of personal effects of passengers arriving in the United States from the line that has prevailed during recent years, when other than actual personal effects were allowed to be included in the \$100 exemption. The change is made in conformity with recent decisions of the courts and the board of general appraisers. It is specifically provided that foreigners are privileged to enter with such articles as are necessary for their wearing apparel, of personal adornment, and similar effects accompanying passengers necessary for wear and use for the journey and not intended for other purposes for sale, without regard to the \$100 limitation. Citizens of the United States are privileged to bring such articles if they are bona fide residents of a foreign country.

The court announced that it would await the verdict of the coroner and the case was continued until Feb. 11th.

Need Assistance WASHINGTON, Feb. 4.—A despatch to the State Department from Ambassador Bacon, Paris, states that the needs of the poor are being admirably met by the Red Cross and other charitable organizations, but that the destitute will be in great need of assistance for at least a month to come and therefore further contributions from America will be very acceptable.
