CANADA HAS BIG

TRADE BALANCE
Totals Nearly Two Hundred Million
Dollars for Twelve Months Ending
With May.—Large Increase in
Exports.

Ottawa, June 28— (Canadian
Press).—Canada has a favorable
trade balance of nearly \$300,000,000
for the twelve months ended May 31.
During that period Canadian products exported were worth \$1,009,-715,880. Imports totalled \$473,867,-762. Duty totalled \$132,956,408.

Exports increased by \$110,000,000
over 1923 and imports increased by
\$32,000,000. The chief increase in
exports was in agricultural products
and wood and paper.
