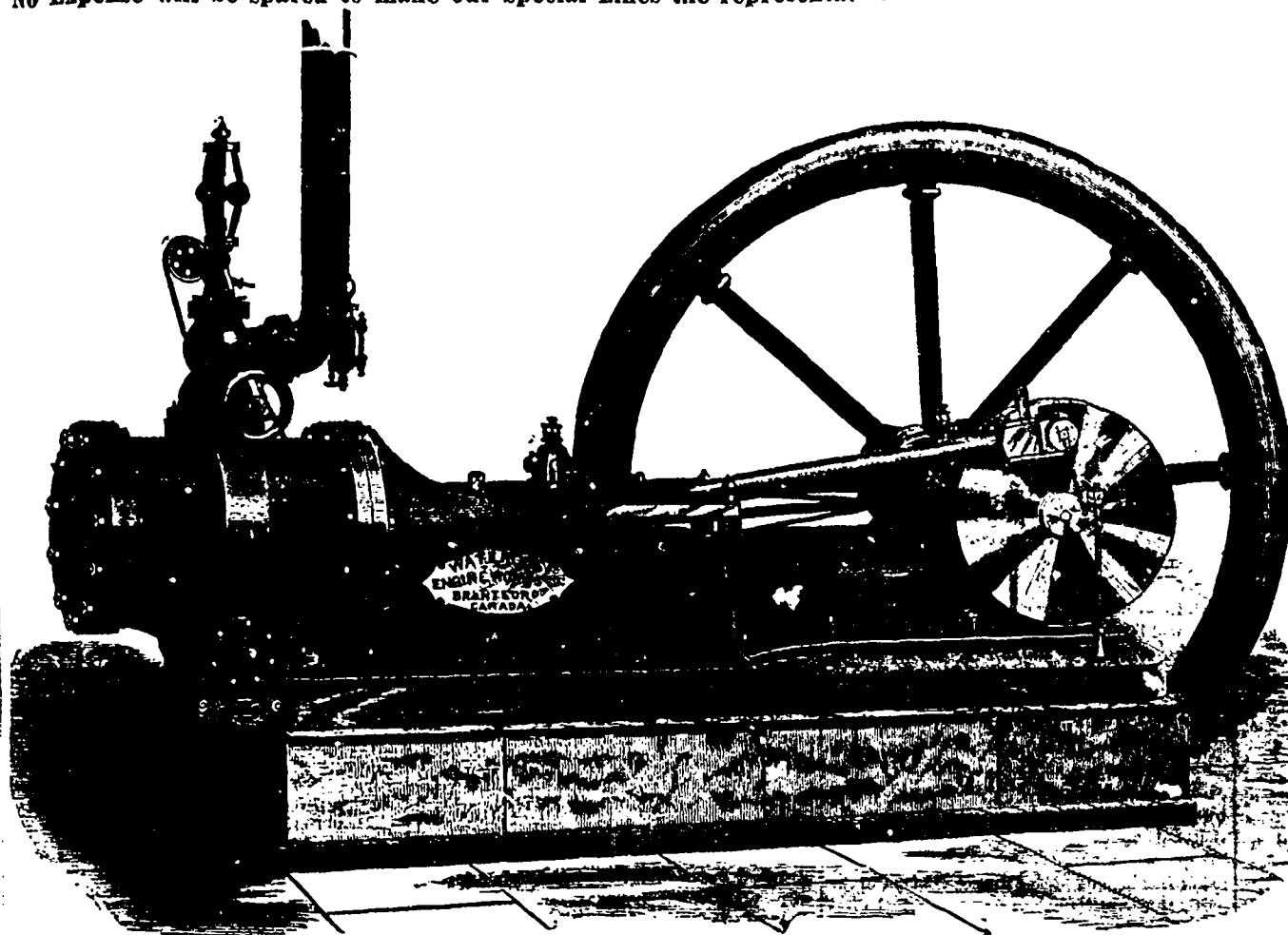


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The London papers are fairly unanimous in insisting upon the resignation of Mr. Gladstone without waiting for an adverse vote of the House.
