HELD:—(Reversing Archibald, J.)—That a declaration alleging that the plaintiff was authorized to sell, for a commission, certain shares of a mining company; that he found a purchaser therefor, but that the sale did not take place because the defendants imposed new conditions on the purchaser, is sufficient in law to maintain an action for the recovery of the commission which would have been obtained under the said sale, especially where an acknowledgment to owe and a promise to pay are alleged to have been made by the defendants.—p. 457.

HELD:—That in an action for work done in some houses according to a contract, subject to the approval of experts, the plaintiff will be allowed to send expert witnesses to view the houses in which the said work is supposed to have been done, in order to enable them to give intelligently their testimony in the cause.—p. 82.
