

**ARTICLE V**

The Parties shall take measures to ensure that the protected line is established at the earliest opportunity after the signature of this Agreement.

Each of the Parties, in accordance with the list to be agreed upon by their agencies and in accordance with the design mutually agreed, shall acquire equipment, spare parts and materials necessary for the establishment and operation of the protected line, and shall implement on its own the technical designs to be chosen.

**ARTICLE VI**

The establishment, bringing into operation, technical operation, and modernization of the protected line between Ottawa and Moscow shall be carried out in the territory of Canada by the Canadian side and in the territory of the Russian Federation by the Russian side. Each of the Parties undertakes to take all necessary measures to ensure the uninterrupted functioning of the protected line within its own territory. In case of the failure of the protected line caused by a fault outside national borders, both Parties shall take measures to restore communication in accordance with the procedures established by the International Telecommunication Union.

**ARTICLE VII**

This Agreement shall enter into force from the date of its signature. It may be terminated by either Party six months after notification given in writing to the other Party.
