To exchange in 1980-82 for a period up to two weeks, visits of delegations of archivists, one mission from each country, consisting of two experts, to familiarize themselves with the work on specific questions of interest to archivist organizations of both countries, and to exchange information on existing archival systems and research and development under way in the field of rapid-seeking techniques. The sending side will be responsible for return fare and the receiving side will bear the costs of internal travel and will pay a per diem to cover the costs of accommodation and meals. The Central Archive Administration under the Council of Ministers of the USSR will also consider concrete proposals for cooperation submitted by archival institutions of the Provinces of Canada. Such proposals will be considered and negotiated through diplomatic channels;

11. To explore the possibility of holding seminars in Canada and in the USSR to discuss subjects of common interest.

#### XI GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The exchange of information and visits mentioned in this Programme do not exclude other exchanges which can be implemented independently by organizations, groups and individuals.

2. Both parties will strive to provide the best conditions of work and sojourn for all participants in Canadian-Soviet exchanges provided for by this Programme, in accordance with the laws and regulations of each country.

3. The parties agreed to meet as required over the next two years in order to review the implementation of the present Programme.

This Programme shall come into force on January 1, 1980 and shall remain effective until December 31, 1981.
