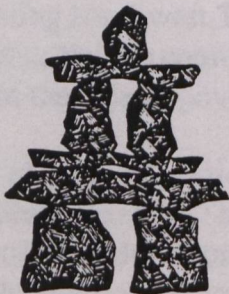


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The Inukshuk

Symbols of Inuit culture and sign posts of their land, Inuksuit (plural of Inukshuk) have been built for thousands of years as trail markers to aid future travellers. Across the tundra, these "rock men" mark the spots where game and fish are plentiful, or where a caribou cache can be found.

Even today, the Inuit construct Inuksuit to point the way over the tundra, and to reassure others that they are on the right path.
