BUSINESS OF THE HOUSE

Mr. Hnatyshyn: Mr. Speaker, I rise on a point of order. There have been consultations between the Opposition House Leaders and myself with respect to the business for today. It was proposed that we carry on consideration now of report stage of Bill C-84, an Act to amend the Income Tax Act.

You will recall, Mr. Speaker, that there was an Order of the House made prior to the Christmas recess which provided for four days of debate on this legislation to complete all stages. On the basis of discussions, it has been agreed that the deliberations today, even though we have not used a whole day on Bill C-84, would constitute one day with respect to the four days contemplated by that Order.

I would ask you, therefore, Mr. Speaker, to put the matter to the House for unanimous consent. I think you will find a disposition to receive it and accept it without debate that we do consider this as one day of the four day debate.
