Dear Sir Arthur Currie:-

In some educational circles in the United States it is felt that the time is opportune when the Universities of both countries might undertake to deepen the mutual understanding between the citizenry of the two nations. You will observe that it deals with North America as a whole, the lectures for the first four weeks dealing exclusively with the Dominion of Canada.
