A Memorandum
On a Proposal for
Export Bounties on
Canadian Manufactures

This proposal suggests the paying of bounties out of the proceeds of general taxation to all Canadian manufacturers who sell anything outside of Canada; and to pay ^{to} the large business more than the small, not only absolutely, but even in proportion to the business done.

It is to be noted that the proposal involves bounties on the whole of the existing export trade in manufactures; that it involves bounties paid on articles consumed in the United States to the extent of the whole difference of the cost of production in the United States and
