

## XI.

Seal of  
Section.

The seal of the Section shall have the words "Bar of Lower Canada, Section of the District of Montreal," and "*Barreau du Bas Canada, Section du District de Montréal*," inscribed on the margin, and shall bear a device of a pillar, with a scroll twined round it, bearing the word "Justice," inscribed on the scroll, and under the base of the column, the words "Inc. A. D. 1849."

## XII.

Custody of  
Seal.

The custody of the seal shall be in the Secretary for the time being, who shall countersign every deed or instrument to which he shall affix the seal.

## XIII.

Deeds and  
instruments,  
how execu-  
ted.

All deeds and instruments entered into for the interest of the Section shall, after approval by the Council, be signed by the *Bâtonnier*, and countersigned by the Secretary, who shall also affix the seal thereto.

## XIV.

Bye-Laws of  
General  
Council to be  
registered.

All bye-laws, rules and orders of the general Council shall, on receipt thereof, be transcribed by the Secretary into the register of proceedings of the Section, and shall, together with all by-laws, rules and orders, adopted by the Council of the Section, be published, for the information of the members of the Section, in the French and English languages, and in such manner as the Council shall order.

## XV.

Funds of  
Section.

The funds of the Section shall be regularly deposited in some Incorporated Bank in the City of Montreal, to be appointed by the Council, and shall only
