



The New York State Legislature Will Not

The New York state Legislature Will Not Permit Illegal Use of Mnils. Albany, April 14.—In the Senate to-day Mr. Platt introduced a bill that provides that any person who shall knowingly be a party to the transmis-sion by telephone, telegraph, mail or express, or otherwise, from one State or Teritory into another, of any gam-bling bet or report of such bet, or the odds quoted on any race or prize fight or other event, or who shall knowingly receive or transmit such reports, or of any lottery, drawing or scheme by means of eipher or otherwise, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable in the first offence by imprisonment for not more than two years, or by a fine of not more than \$1000, or both, and in the second and after offences by im-prisonment only.




