## His Chief Argument Was to Represent That the Government Had a Larger Surplus Than Commission Claims.

There Was a Considerable Increase in Expenditure, But He Thought the Province Could Stand It—Mr. Matheson Begins His Reply.

It would be impossible to imagine a dinner of more than the couple of hours of mumbled, disconnected talk of yesterday afternoon, which Premier Ross called his budget speech. The speaker, who was followed by the aid of an able and supplied to the House there was little in it.

The principal point he made was to represent a larger surplus than the report of the Financial Commission's. The speaker made the surplus \$1,007,873. Mr. Ross figured it out at \$220,000.

**His Estimates Increased.**
