**Synopsis of Canadian North-West Land Regulations**

The sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the District. Entry by proxy is not allowed.

Duties.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of 160 acres, on certain conditions. A habitable house is required, except where residence is performed in the vicinity.

A settler who has exhausted his homestead right may take a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$5.00 per acre.

Duties.—Must reside six months in the district, cultivate 50 acres, and erect a house worth \$200.
