

The Congregation is divided into EIGHT DISTRICTS, each of which is assigned to an Elder. It is his duty to visit the families in his District, to note changes of residence, and to inform the Minister and Session of special cases of sickness or poverty.

DISTRICT NO. I.—JAMES LILLIE, *Elder.*

From Papineau Road and Square, East, including Hochelaga, Longue Pointe and Longueuil.

DISTRICT NO. II.—JOHN A. STUART, *Elder.*

From Papineau Road and Square, West to Campeau street, including the latter.

DISTRICT NO. III.—GILBERT A. FLETCHER, *Elder.*

From Campeau Street to Gosford and St. Constant Streets, the latter excluded.

DISTRICT NO. IV.—J. H. MICHAUD, *Elder.*

From St. Constant Street, included, to Bleury Street, excluded, and from Dorchester Street, excluded, northwards.

DISTRICT NO. V.—THOMAS GRAHAM, *Elder.*

From St. Constant Street, included, to Bleury Street, excluded, and from Craig Street to Dorchester Street, both included.

DISTRICT NO. VI.—ROBERT BRODIE, *Elder.*

From Bleury Street, included, westwards, and from St. Antoine Street, included, northwards.

DISTRICT NO. VII.—WILLIAM DARLING, Jr., *Elder.*

From Gosford Street, westwards, and southward of Craig and St. Antoine Streets, both excluded.

DISTRICT NO. VIII.—DANIEL DRUMMOND, *Elder.*

Petite Cote, St. Michel, and all outside the city limits northwards.
