

**\$50,000 FOR INVENTION.**  
George Sperti Devises Meter to Measure Lost Electric Current.

Cincinnati, April 26.—Solving a problem that has puzzled experts since electricity was first put into commercial use, George Sperti, a student in the Engineering College at the University of Cincinnati, has perfected a meter which not only measures current producing power but also current lost in transmission.

While the meter has not yet been patented, the Westinghouse Electric Company thinks so much of it that it has paid Sperti for an option on the device and has agreed to give him \$50,000 for the American rights to it as soon as the patent is granted.

Charles P. Steinmetz has estimated that the meter will save \$100,000,000 in electrical current in the United States each year. Mr. Steinmetz is consulting engineer for the General Electric Company.

Sperti is twenty-two years old. He said that he could not understand why some one had not stumbled on his discovery before. Fundamentally, it consists in taking the square root of the squares of the active current and the inactive current.
