

During a three months' period the Sheldon boy is credited with making fifty-eight loaves of bread in nineteen bakings, seventy-six hours of housework in helping his mother and forty-eight hours in running errands for the house.





### FALL MODELS KNEE LENGTH

Washington, June 30.—Conservation of cloth at the expense of womanly modesty will not be endorsed by the government, representatives of the National Garment Retailers' Association were told by Howard Figg, assistant to the attorney general in charge of the campaign to reduce prices. The retailers presented for Mr. Figg's inspection three living models dressed in knee length gowns designed as the extreme in women's wear for next fall. Mr. Figg declined to indicate what he considered a proper length for skirts, but declared after viewing the extreme styles that skirts should "at least come below the waist."

The retailers approved Mr. Figg's suggestion that coming styles should be changed as little as possible so that women might get the full wear out of their clothes and not feel compelled to refill their wardrobes frequently because of the differing modes.
