"But perhaps among the poorer classes"

"You'll find lots of fine children among the poorer families," the chief interrupted, getting the idea before it was expressed. "And if one poor woman can bring up a family to be decent, respectable citizens, there is no reason why they all can't do it.

"The whole trouble lies in the fact that the children are allowed to run the streets at night. You will see them after twelve o'clock playing around the corners. There are little boys and young girls all over the city, whose parents do not seem to object to their being out after midnight."

"Would you favor a curfew law by which the police could force children to go home early in the evening," he was asked.

"Yes, I think it would be a spleadid idea if the council would pass some sort of a by-law forbidding children to be on the street after nine or ten o'clock. It would be enforced, and I think it would be a great deal to prevent children from going wrong."
