SAYS CANADIAN HAD DUAL LIFE

Wife of Grandson of E. B. Eddy, Hull Matchmaker, Brings Sensational Suit For Divorce.

(Canadian Press Despatch.)
New York, Aug. 28.—Summons and complaint in an action for divorce brought by his wife were served yesterday at the Hotel Astor on Ezra Butler Eddy, grandson of Ezra Butler Eddy, match manufacturer of Ottawa.
Service of the papers was made in dramatic fashion by Mrs. Eddy's attorney while the young Canadian was at dinner with his wife at the hotel. As Eddy was passing the bread to his wife, the attorney handed him the summons. Another unusual feature of the incident was that a woman named as co-respondent in the divorce proceedings accompanied the attorney and pointed out Eddy as "that man."

In her petition Mrs. Eddy asks that her husband's funds be withheld from his use temporarily. Her affidavit charges that he is a "hard and consistent drinker, a waster, and that she fears he will imperil his income of not less than \$100,000 a year."
The co-respondent, whose name has been withheld, is said in the petition to have resided with Eddy in New York for a considerable time as his wife. Mrs. Eddy discovered the alleged dual life of her husband.
