## SUNDAY TRAGEDIES.

**PROVIDENCE, R. I., April 14.**—An automobile containing William Evans, Superintendent of the Hargraves, and Parker Mill, of Fall River, and his family, ran down and seriously injured John Elvey, a ten year old child, on Wickenden street today. The child is said to have stepped suddenly from the curbstone directly in front of the machine. He suffered fractures of the skull and jaw and is not expected to recover.

Mr. Evans furnished bail in the sum of \$2,500 on the charge of assault and the hearing of the case was set for April 23.

**RIGA, Russia, April 13.**—There was a serious mutiny in the local prison today. Thirty-three inmates attacked and overcame the superintendent and the warden of the establishment. Troops were then sent and the conditions were such that they had to fire. Seven of the mutineers were killed and 12 were wounded. The superintendent of the prison was badly beaten.

**SAN ANTONIO, Tex., April 13.**—A special from Mexico City, Mexico, says:—One wing of the city jail collapsed today entombing 20 prisoners, two of whom were killed. Even one confined in the wing was hurt, and five fatally.

**NORTH ADAMS, Mass., April 14.**—James Walley, Jr., for many years an engraver at the Windsor Print Works in this city, committed suicide today by shooting. Walley was 39 years old and unmarried. He is believed to have been despondent over the failure of the management of the Print works to re-engage him, when the company started up recently after a two years shut down.

**KEY WEST, Fla., April 14.**—An explosion which occurred on the dredger George W. Allen, engaged in extensive work on the Florida coast, R. R., at Key West, early today caused the death of two Spaniards, Jose Ando and Manuel Aguirre, and injured eight others.

Four of the injured were badly scalded on the hands and face. A tube in the boiler is said to have burst, the scalding steam blowing open the furnace doors and throwing coals and steam on the men who were killed.

Those injured were asleep at the time of the explosion. The steam blew off a partition on the dredger, which was not otherwise damaged.

**NEW HAVEN, Conn., April 13.**—An express train on the New York, New Haven and Hartford R. R. killed a man at Stamford this afternoon when, according to the engineer, deliberately jumped in front of the engine. His clothes bore no identifying mark, neither did those of a man killed by a train at Windsor, on the Hartford division earlier in the day.

**PITTSBURG, Pa., April 14.**—Robert M. Crowe, a nephew of H. C. McDowell, president of the Union Trust Company of this city, who shot himself in the abdomen while in a box watching a performance at a local theatre last Wednesday afternoon, died at a hospital today. Crowe was 23 years old and a member of a prominent family. The shooting, which almost caused a panic in the theatre, is attributed to financial difficulties.

**ALEXANDRIA, La., April 14.**—Three men were killed and one probably fatally injured is the result of what is believed to be the work of train wreckers at Cheneyville, thirty miles southeast of here on the Texas and Pacific R. R. early this morning when a west-bound passenger train plunged into an open switch while running at a high speed. The wreckage caught fire.

**NEW YORK, N. Y., April 14.**—Policeman George M. Scher and Alfred Solman, were shot and fatally wounded by Salvatore Governale, in a running fight which began in Washington Square and ended in a tenement in West Third street. Scher died soon after he was shot. Governale immediately after his arrest was hurried to the hospital where he was identified by the three dying men.

**MARLBORO, Mass., April 14.**—Medical Examiner E. G. Holt decided today that a shock of electricity caused the death of Miss Anna W. Greenwood, who was found dead last evening sitting beside a telephone instrument at her home. Contact made by the young woman's body with telephone and electric light circuits, as she was in the act of ringing the telephone and turn-

ing an electric light switch is believed to have brought about the accident. On one of the young woman's wrists is a burned spot just at the point where a metallic cut link probably came in contact with the electric light switch, while on the other hand are two burned spots, where the set screws of the telephone receiver apparently rested. The medical examiner said that he did not consider there was negligence on the part of either the telephone or electric light company, but that the happening was an unfortunate one, the responsibility for which has not been fixed. An autopsy will be held tomorrow.

## STRUCK BY SNOWBALL; HE MAY BECOME BLIND

Edward Riley, who, until last Thursday was a teamster for J. S. Gibson and Co., may be totally blind as a result of being struck in the eye by a snowball. Riley who is now twenty-five years of age, lost the sight of his left eye when he was only four years of age. Some boys threw some sand in his face which destroyed the sight. Since then he has been able to work at hauling coal and other outside jobs, but although he has a fair education he could not work in an office as his eyesight was poor. On Thursday Riley was driving down Main street. Ward Stevens was in the cart with Riley. Riley was walking along the street when he was struck in the right eye by a snowball. Riley was unable to work any longer and was taken to his aunt's home on Pond street. Dr. Fritzsche was summoned, had Riley removed to the hospital. The eye is in a serious condition and the doctors are not confident of saving it. Riley bears no bad feeling toward Stevens as he does not think the lad meant to hit him with the snowball.

**TROUT FISHING BOGS IN ENGLISH HOTEL.**  
LONDON, April 13.—The trout fishing season at the Carlton Hotel begins today.

The experiment initiated last year of keeping live trout in a tank so that visitors might select their fish and catch it themselves if they would and have it served at table an hour later, was so successful that the hotel authorities are starting their trout fishery nearly four months earlier than last year.

Between July and October last nearly 2,500 trout were thus caught and cooked at the Carlton. The figures will probably be doubled this year.

Mr. Jacques Kraemer, the manager of the hotel, told a newspaperman yesterday that between sixty and eighty trout will be put into the tank today, and that eighteen of the fish will be selected specimens weighing up to six pounds apiece.

"Customers will again have the privilege of catching their own fish if they like," he said, "and they will have the satisfaction of knowing they could not fare better if they landed their trout on the bank of a Highland loch. The trout will come fresh from Scotland every day."
