French Nations in America, as well Northern as Southern; and within the Islands, Colonies, Forts, Cities and Governments (without exception of Places) belonging to the most Serene King of Great Britain, or to the most Serene most Christian King, and which are under the Jurisdiction of either King. respectively.

II.

That no Ships or Vessels, great or small belonging to the moft Serene King of Great Britain's Subjects in the faid English Islands, Colonies, Forts, Cities and Governments, shall be fitted out or imployed to Invade or Attack the most Serene most Christian King's Subjects in their Islands, Colonies, Forts, Cities and Governments, or to do them any injury or damage. In like manner that no Ships or Veffels, great or small, belonging to the most Serene most Christian King's Subjects in the faid French Islands, Colonies, Forts, Cities and Governments, thall be fitted out, or imployed to Invade or Attack the most Serene King of Great Britain's Subjects in
