Govt. to Eng., on subject of Inter-colonial Railway, 1858; and to the Quebec Union Conference, 1864. Was a mem. of the Leg. Council, N. S., before the Union. DICKSON, *Lieut. Col. Hon.* WALTER HAMILTON.

S. of the late Hon. W. Dickson, a mem. of the Leg. Council of U. C. B. in U. C. Called to the Bar, U. C., in Hilary Term, 1830. Sat for Niagara in L. A. Can., from 1844 to 1851. Was a life mem. of the Leg. Council, Can., from Feb., 1855, until the Union. Called to the Senate by Royal Proclamation, May, 1867. A Conservative.—*Niagara, Ont.*

DUCHESNAY, *Lieut. Col. Hon.* ANTOINE JUSCHEREAU.

S. of the late Colonel Michael Louis Juschereau Duchesnay, *Seigneur de Fossambault*, who became at an early age an officer in the then 60th Regt. retired to enjoy his patrimonial estates, and was eventually appointed Deputy Adjutant General of Militia, by Charlotte Hermine Louise Catherine de Salaberry. Is cousin of the Hon. E. H. J. Duchesnay, Senator. Sat for Portneuf in L. A., Can., from 1848 to 1851. Is a *Seigneur* of P. Q., and *Lieut. Col.* commanding 4th Battalion Portneuf Militia. Represented La Salle division in Leg.
