

tor Palatine shall be fully re-established; in conformity to the Article above mention'd. In the Month following shall the said Lady Dutcheſs produce in the ſame place, the whole and intire explanation of her Pretensions or Demands againſt the Elector, which ſhall be communicated to him within eight days following. There ſhall be within the ſpace of four Months next enſuing, explain'd and delivered to the Deputies of the Lords Arbitrators, who ſhall ſet down the day that the four Months ſhall begin, the Reaſons and Grounds of the two Parties, whereof four Copies ſhall be delivered; that is to ſay, one for each Arbitrator, and a third to be annex to the common Acts of the Arbitration, and a fourth to be interchangeably communicated within ſeven days to each Party. They ſhall in like manner answer; and four Copies of the Answer of each Party ſhall be given the ſame day to the Envoys of the Lords Arbitrators, which ſhall be once more communicated within ſeven days to the Parties interchangeably. In the four Months following, the Inſtruction of the Buſineſs ſhall be terminated on each ſide, the Parties ſhall declare they are willing to ſubmit to the Verdict of the Arbitrators, and this concluſion of the Inſtruction and Commiſſion ſhall be communicated to the Parties, that they may take cogniſance of the ſame; and the Deeds ſhall be Enrolled in preſence of the Solicitors of the ſaid Parties. After that the Arbitrators and their Deputies who ſhall have taken an Oath, having view'd and examin'd the Right of the Parties during the ſpace of ſix Months enſuing, ſhall pronounce their Sentence publickly in the place where the Conference is held, according to the Laws and Conſtitutions of the
