The funds and property of the said Corporation shall be used5 and applied to and for such purposes only as may be calculated to promote and extend the lawful trade and commerce of this Dominion generally, and of the Town of Windsor in particular, or as may be necessary to attain the objects for which the said Corporation is constituted, according to the true intent and 10 meaning of this Act.
3. The usual place of mecting of the said Corporation shail be held to be the legal domicile thereof, and service at such place of any notice, or process of any kind, addressed to the snid Corpora- 15 tion, shall be held to be sufficient service of such notice or process on the Corporation.

4. For the management of the afiairs and business of the said Corpmation. Corporation, there shall be a Council to be called "The Council of the Board of Trade," which shall, from and after the first election 20 hereinafter mentionel, consist of a President, two Vice-Presidents, Secretary-Treasurer, and seven other members of the said Council, all of whom shall be members of the said Corporation, and shall have the powers and perform the dities hereinafter mentioned and assigned to the said Council.
