there shall not be taken on board any such Ship or Veffel any more such Paffengers than are herein-after permitted and allowed; which Bond shall be taken by and deposited with the Collector and Comptroller, or other principal Officer of His Majeity's Cuftoms at the Port from which fuch Ships or Veffels shall fail; and the Master or other Person, having or taking the Charge or Command of fuch Ship or Veffel previous to his leaving the faid Port, shall and is hereby required to deliver to the faid Collector and Comptroller, or other principal Officer of His Majefty's Customs at the faid Port, a List containing the Number of the faid Paffengers, with their Names, Ages, and Defcriptions, for the Purpole of being registered at such Port, together with a Copy of the same, which Copy shall be certified by the faid Officers as being correct and true, and deliver to the Master or other Person having or taking the Charge or Command of fuch Ship or Vessel to be by him kept on board the faid Veffel, and fubject to the Infpection of any of His Majefty's Ships of War or Veffels in the Service of His Majelty's Cultoms or Excile, during his Voyage to Newfoundland and the Coaft of Labrador; and upon the Arrival of fuch Ship or Veffel at either of the aforefaid Places, the faid Master, or other Person having or taking the Charge or Command of fuch Ship or Veffel, shall deliver the aforefaid Copy of the Lift to the Governor of fuch Place or other Person acting for him, or to the Naval Officer or Chief Officer of the Cuftoms at the Port of Arrival, or to the nearest Justice of the Peace who shall be required to examine the Pasfengers within Twenty-four Hours after their Arrival; and no fuch Paffenger as aforefaid shall be allowed to land until such List is compared with the Paffengers by the Governor or other Perfon acting for him, or fome Person authorized by either of them for that Purpole.

II. And be it further enacted, That if the Master, or other Person having or taking the Charge or Command of fuch Ship or Veffel, fhall take or have on board his Ship or Veffel, or if the Owner or Owners of fuch Ship or Veffel shall engage to take on board more Persons than the Number allowed, they shall respectively forfeit the Sum of Ten Pounds for each Perfon fo taken or engaged to be taken on board.

III. And be it further enacted, That from and after the paffing of this Act it shall not be lawful for any Ship or Vessel from any Place in the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, or from Guernsey and Jersey, to carry to any Part of Newfoundland or Coast of Labrador a greater Number of Paffengers than in the following Proportion; that is to fay, any Britifh Ship or Veffel having a Second Deck may take Paffengers at the Rate of One for every unoccupied Space being Six Feet in Length by Two Feet in Breadth, and being of the full perpendicular Height between the Two Decks; or any Britifb Ship or Veffel which shall have only One Deck over her Hold may take Passengers at the Rate of One for every Space between the Cargo stowed in the Hold and the Deck, being Six Feet in Length and Two Feet in Breadth, and being the Height of Five Feet perpendicular above the Cargo, and being independent in either. Cafe of the Space which may be requifite for the Stowage of the Water and Provisions and Baggage of the Passengers, and the full Space before mentioned shall accordingly be allotted for the Accommodation of each Paffenger fo taken on board. · · ja . -

IV. And
