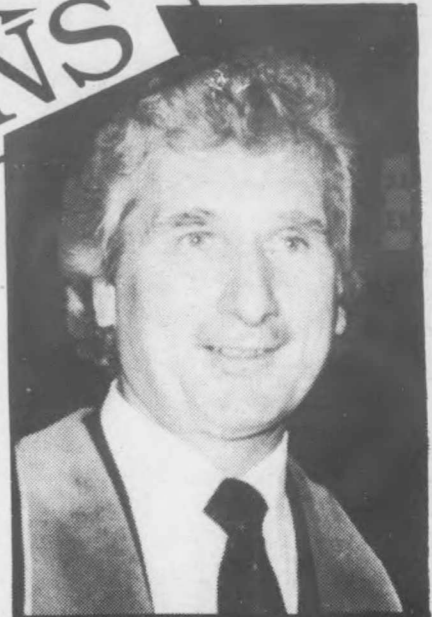
MANILOW RESIGNS
