

the Indians were very orderly and well behaved.

The foregoing facts are verified by both Agent McDonald and Constable O'Connell, who looked after the Indians while in New Westminster and accompanied them to the hop fields at Chilliwack and Agassiz.

After ascertaining the foregoing facts I do not feel disposed to recommend the construction of any new buildings on private property in the city of New Westminster, which might in the near future be required by the owners for personal use.
