## 5. CONCLUSION:

As a result, therefore, I am of the opinion that additional equipment should be provided to ensure protection of this port and that this equipment is necessary from a national standpoint and is also necessary for the Civilian Defence of the City of Vancouver because, as previously pointed out, a series of uncontrolled fires on the waterfront would probably spread and cause incalculable damage.

## RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. I therefore recommend that the sum of sixty thousand dollars be provided to purchase the equipment suggested.
- 2. That the Provincial Civilian Protection Committee be authorized to proceed with arrangements to secure this equipment as soon as possible.
- 3. That such Committee be authorized to make suitable arrangements for the operation and maintenance of this apparatus in the whole harbour area but without further expense to the Federal Government.
