No 3. — Remark does not state that son No 49 is married, and whom he took for his wife

No 6. — Boy married but remark does not shew to whom

No 14. — Remark does not state who the other relation is,

No 26. 1885 P.S. states 4 girls, 1886 P.S. states 4 boys, which is correct,

In one or two cases Remarks state Grandchild dead, It should be Grandson or granddaughter as the case may be, otherwise the sex cannot be determined without referring to back pay sheets.

It is also advisable when a son or daughter is shewn to be married to also shew under what number they draw, so that they may be traced.
