

Receipt is acknowledged of your letter of March 15th, 1955, your file 107/3-3-184, concerning Mrs. Clarisse Custer, common-law wife of George Custer, listed under No. 90 of the Peter Ballantyne Band.

We have searched our records and we note that by letter of October 11th, 1934, copy herewith, arrears of annuity for the years 1930 to 1934 were requested for Mrs. Custer. These arrears, in the amount of \$25.00, were paid by the Department.

Our records indicate further that on June 13th, 1936, Clara White, wife of Percy White, a non-Indian, was granted her commutation. The application indicates that Clara White was formerly Clara Cusiter listed under No. 210 of the Peter Ballandyne Band.
