



Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 20th instant, embodying a resolution of Council to the effect that \$12.00 be paid to the women who white-washed the basement of the church at Saugeen, and scrubbed the same, etc, I beg to say that in view of your report that you do not consider the work performed worth that amount, the Department can not approve of payment at the rate mentioned. If, as you say, you consider \$5.00 a fair rate of remuneration for the work performed, and the women are willing to accept \$5.00 each, you may submit vouchers in their favour for that amount.
