
Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 22nd ultimo, I beg to say that the accounts which you forwarded were, in accordance with the usual custom, submitted to the Department of Justice for taxation. The Deputy Minister of Justice has returned them to this Department in a letter of the 30th ultimo, He writes as follows:-
