
Paul Bear, an Indian of Red Pheasant's Band has written the Department asking to be transferred to Petequake Band, Carlton Agency, on the ground that he could make more progress in farming on the latter Reserve which he states is more suitable than his own.

He also requests that in the event of his being transferred he be allowed to take his cattle and property with him.

The Department would like to have your views as to the advisability or otherwise, of transferring this Indian giving reasons in support of your statements.

You should also report the number and kind of live stock and other property owned by Bear and how it is held.
