

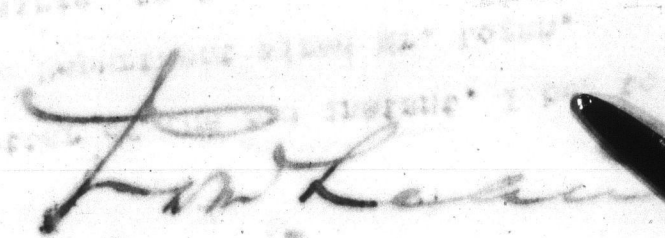

Sir:-

With reference to letter to you of the 11th July, 1910 in which the Department requested that you add to the list of officers of this Department under bond, the name of Mr. K.C.
