I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant stating that Wm. Narvey, Constable of the Eel River Reserve, has written you with reference to the necessity of appointing a truant officer for that reserve and has indicated his willingness to act in that capacity.

In reply I beg to say that the Department will be glad to accept Mr. Narvey's services as trush officer for this reserve and will pay him at the rate of \$25.00 per annum for this services from the re-opening of the school after the summer holidays. I am sending you herewith for his guidance a copy of the Regulations relating to the Education of Indian Children, in sections 5, 6 and 7 of which the duties of trush officers are defined.
