- (5) Such other officers, clerks and servants as are necessary for the proper conduct of thebusiness of the branch and the administration and enforcement of these regulations shall be appointed in the manner provided by law.
- 603.(1) For the purposes of Part IV, Canada is hereby divided into thirteen Administrative Divisions, as set out in Schedule "C".
- (2) The Director mays from time to time, by notice in the Canada Gazette, increase or decrease the number of Divisions in Canada and may, from time to time in like manner, fix the boundaries of any Division.
- 604.(1) The Governor in Council shall establish in each Division a Board which shall consist of such members as the Governor in Council may appoint and shall be called The Draft Board for the Division.
- (2) The Governor in Council shall appoint one member of each Board as Chairman thereof and the Director may appoint one or more members as Deputy Chairman.
- (3) The Governor in Council shall appoint a Registrar for each Division who shall be called the Divisional Registrar of the Division.
- to be paid to the Director, Associate Directors, Assistant Directors, members of The Draft Boards and Medical Revision Boards, Divisional Registrars and examining physicians, and the Director shall determine the remuneration to be paid to such other officers, clerks and employees as may be appointed under these regulations.
- of the Director may by agreement borrow the services of a person employed by a department or agency of the Government of Canada or a private employer and may pay remuneration to such person or reimburse his employer for all or part of his remuneration by such payments as may be approved by the Governor in Council.
- 607.(1) The Director may, at pleasure, suspend a member of a Board, a
