The follage seems to be intermediate between the European raspberry Rubus Idigus and the American Rubus Strigosus. The canes have been

affected to some event 'y anthrachose, but not more than Cuthbert or Marlboro' growing a singuide. Fruit large, round; drupes large, deep garnet, firm, very joing, pleasantly acid and exceptionally rich. See Fig. 6. A few ripe perries were seen last year, and this year, at the time of the first picking of Cuthbert, but the main crop did not ripen till the season of Cuthbert was over, the last picking taking place each year from the 8th to 12th August.
