if at such special meeting a majority vote (by ballor) of the members present at such meeting flecide that the retirement of such member is desirable, such member's name shall be erased from the roll, and such rerson shall have no claim against the Society or its funds.

LIBRARY.

- 24. There shall be a Library in connection with this Society, to consist of books on the Spiritual Philosophy.
- 25. There shall bos a library fund maintained by donations, by library fees, fines and an appropriation from the Society of twenty-five cents per year for each member. The Librarian shall keep an accurate account of such fund.
- 26. Every member wishing to become a borrower, shall pay a library fee of fifty cents per year in advance; but the right to borrow books ceases with membership, when over five months in arrears.
- Books borrowed shall be returned to the Librarian at a meeting of the Society, within one month, but may be borrowed again. If not so returned or renewed the borrower shall be fined twenty-five cents for every two weeks, or part of two weeks thereafter. Said fine shall be paid by the Society to the library fund and be part thereof. The Secretary shall notify the delingdent borrower of such fine, and the amount to be charged against the borrower as one month's dues in arrears. The borrower shall be responsible that the borrowed book be returned in as good condition as it was taken out; and to replace any book subject to the usual fines, for not replacing it within one month.
