GRASS GOING TO WAST

P.E. Island Neglecting a Valuable In

dustry on the Shores.

(Special Correspondence.)

(Charlottetown, P.E.L., May 22.—Thou sands of dollars of sea grass go twaste on the Coast of Prince Edwar. Island annually for want of a little enterpise and work and effort in findin markets for such products as sea grass less, etc. There is a large quantit of the sea grass in all the harbors of the coast where the bottom is mu which goes to waste, and for whice there is a constantly growing deman from the manufacturers of materesses upholsterers, especially those who make a specialty of upholstering the backs of automobiles and in the manufacturer of artificial rubber, wrough from pipe and wire burned for manufacturing chemicals. The supply of sea grass at present comes from Bar of Chaleurs and the Lower St. Law rence River points, such as Rimouski sile Verte and other stations, also from western United States points using the sea grass. The method of getting the sea grass ready for market is put it practice in September and October when the grass is ready for cutting and at low tide is cut as near the bottom as possible so as to have the grassfull length. It is then washed to clear if from sand, mud or small shells, dried on the rocks or land the same as hay and pressed into bales of 100 pounds each, wired with three wires, and is then ready for shipment.

The quality, length and width of the grass has much to do with its value. The longer and firmer it is, the more it is worth. The principal cost of handling the grass, the raw material of which is plentiful and a money-maker, is the labor of puting up, gathering, drying and packing, which is less than the cost of harvesting hay and getting it ready for shipping.
