A Bill which declares in whom is vested the power of granting des Leures de Terrier in this Province; was, according to order, read for the second time.

On motion of Mr. Bertbelot, seconded by Mr. Roy Portelance,

ORDERED, That the Bill be referred to a Committee of the whole House.

Resolved, That this House will, on Friday next, resolve itself into a 
Committee of the whole House upon the said Bill.

The order of the day for the House to resolve itself into a Committee of the whole upon the Bill to repeal an Ordinance made and passed in the twenty sist year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Ormitalian dinance to prevent the exportation of unmerchantable flour, and the false taring of bread and flour casks," to regulate the packing and inspection of flour, Indian meal and biscuit in future, and to fix a standard weight of wheat within this Province: being read—

The House resolved itself into the said Committee.

Mr. Speaker left the Chair,

Mr. Frobisher took the Chair of the Committee;

Mr. Speaker refumed the Chair,

And Mr. Frobisher reported, that the Committee had gone through the Bill, and made several amendments thereto, which he was directed to submit to the House, whenever it should be pleased to receive the same.

ORDERED, That the report be received to-morrow.

And then, on motion of Mr. Roy Portelance, seconded by Mr. Fro-bisher,

The House adjourned.
