A Few Tips for the Boys' Glee Club in Schools. The boys' glee club should be con-


sidered by all the school as a special ized course of instruction in singing for boys. It denotes a considerable degree of talent and training. Al-



Lake Casts Up Sulphate.

When the water of Salt Lake, Utah reaches a temperature below 30 de-grees Fahrenheit, it manufactures sodium sulphate and accommodatingly casts it up on the beach. The fact that the deposit of sodium sulphate can be gathered before it goes back into solu tion has led to the construction of a plant for harvesting and refining the material into a commercial product. The average period of production will be two months each year. During a eason of mild winter there may be none produced and during years of cold winter the sodium sulphate may be precipitated for three months judging by weather records of twenty


