of a hundred families or so from Moncton, or the substraction of a few hundred miles of railway from the jurisdiction of some divisional superintendent, it might be passed over lightly. If the divisional arrangements affected only a few locapoints, then any complaint would be sectional, but there are issues involved which mke the question one of national importance and especially so to the Maritime Provinces.

If the proposed arrangement is adhered to, the western terminal of the Atlantic Division of the C.N.R. will be at River du Loup, a point about 300 miles east of Montreal, and

one at which little if any through or export freight originates. The next western divisional point, Toronto, will embrace the sources of traffic at the head of the Great Lakes and Montreal. It will also include the Grand Trunk Railway system with its outlet at Portland Maine.

Citizens of the Maritime Provinces should not lose sight of the fact that the Toronto division will be anxious to make the very best possible showing in earnings for the division, and will naturally route all through freight to Portland, Me., while the Atlantic Division will be left without a solitary point at whilch export traffic originates.

It has always been recognized that those who laid the foundation of the National Railway system, intended that every pound of freight originating at a Canadian point should be carried through Canadian ports the whole year round; but it would seem, the present scheme, with Toronto authorities anxious to make their division pay and not showing and great sympathy towards the Maritimes, there is a grave danger that

Montreal is the logical boundary for an Atlantic Division and it is trange that any change should be thus early made.

No one wishes to array east against west, but the question which has arisen may well be made a test case, as to whether all parts of Carada are to have an equal recognition given to their just claims.

We want to see the C.N.R. put or paying basis as well as any other portion of the dominion, but we also want to see the Maritime Provinces treated as well as Montreal or av onto. In so far as "No Politics in the C.N.R.." is concerned, this system belongs to the people of Canada and therefore must be controlled by the Federal government. As to detail of management, it is generally inderstood that it would be better to have the railway out of politics. but the policy of the railway should be made by the government. This is what was intended when the gov free hand in management. The Gov ernment like any other owner has ciples regarding the management of

This question is one which should be looked at in a broad way; one which affects the Maritime Provinces as a whole, and not any particular point. Because of this, if is a matter of deep concern to every city and wn in the Maritime provinces and one which every Maritime Province member should be keenly interested in: If they fail to interest themselves they are misrepresenting their constituencies and should be told so in no uncertain manner.
